Take the Čezeta 506 Tour

(12) Strahov Monastery

The elegant spires of the basilica, the wonderful period library, the priceless pictures in the gallery and a film set for Hollywood blockbusters – this is Prague's Strahov Monastery, one of the oldest Premonstratensian monasteries still in existence in the world.

(13) Petřín Tower

Set out for the top of Petřín with its elegant lookout tower inspired by the famous Eiffel Tower in Paris! After having conquered the 299 steps, a breathtaking view will open out for you over the panorama of the city with its abundance of spires, chimneys and the spectacular facades of Baroque palaces.

Břevnov Monastery

The monastery was founded in 993 AD, a fine example of High Baroque architecture. It is also known for its brewery, the existence of which

is documented as early as the 13th century, and whose production can be tasted in the monastery even today.

(19) Cubist Villas

At the foot of Vyšehrad, you'll discover the beauty of Czech architectural Cubism immortalized in the crystalline forms of the Kovařovic Villa and other buildings. Cubism in architecture – thoroughly Czech, peculiar, new and fresh.

(20) Vyšehrad Fort

Discover the beginnings of Czech statehood at Vyšehrad. A site standing as a memorial to Czech history, shrouded in legends and myths old as the nation itself, the seat of the mythical Přemysl princes, the last resting place of the most eminent of Czech artists and one of the symbols of Czech statehood.

(21) Grébovka Park and Vineyard

This park, inspired by the Italian Renaissance, has fountains and water cascades, lakes, pavilions, statues and a charming grotto, as well as a unique view of the city. The charming Vineyard Gazebo surrounded by large vineyards and the Grébovka Pavilion garden café, with its unique replica of the original historic bowling alley from the 1870s, offer pleasant places to sit.

(30) Kampa Island

Discover Prague from the seat of a Czech classic.

This park, an island between the Vltava River and its artificial channel, Čertovka, where you will spot a huge

mill wheel from the 15th century former Grand Priory Mill, is one of the most romantic and picturesque places in the city.

33 Stromovka Park

Park.

This large green oasis in the middle

of town trees, charming ponds and grassy lawns making it an ideal place for picnics, walks and relaxation all. It originated in the 13th century as a game reserve. A sort of Prague Hyde

(35) **DOX Centre** for Contemporary Art

This multifunctional space for presenting international and Czech art, architecture and design is located in Prague's Holešovice district, in a renovated complex of industrial buildings from the 19th century. Check out the wooden zeppelin on the roof!

(43) Tricafe

Visiting Tricafe is like visiting an old friend: expect a homey feel, a great

cup of coffee and delicious cake. A perfect escape for when you find yourself trapped by the crowds around the Charles Bridge area in the Old Town.

(47) Místo

Few cafés in Prague offer such complete service as the snazzy Místo – here, premium coffee is served in a spacious modern interior alongside breakfast, lunch, dinner and weekend brunch.
